TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All work entered must be photography and framed or mounted ready for hanging or display and labeled on back/underside of base with entrant name, address, medium, category, title and price.

All works must have multi strand picture wire & flush "D" ring hangers.

A work (Single or Multi Panel) must not exceed 1.5 sq. metres. No dimension can exceed 1500mm. Representations of larger works for sale can be displayed using this format.

Frame 'n' Art (Chiltern, Vic.) can assist with discount rate framing. Phone Chris Brown on 0417 550076
- A work must be an original by the artist and entered by the artist. The work should not have been previously entered into competition within a 100km radius of Corowa NSW. Any work must not infringe the copyrights, moral rights or other rights of any third party.
- Work must not have been previously entered into the Corowa Federation Photographic Prize.
- Work must have been produced within the last 2 years. Proof of date should be available, if requested.
- Work must be signed and dated.
- A work can only be entered in one section.
- All artists are limited to 5 entries in total across all sections. Additional entries will not be exhibited.
- The price and title shown on the entry form for a work will be listed in the catalogue. No exceptions. The price should include any GST which may be applicable. All works must be for sale.
- Open Date for Entries: Friday, March 3rd, 2023
- Entries close 17:00 Friday, April 28th 2023. Entry is via Eventbrite
- Delivery and collection of work must be in person, by a nominated representative of the artist or by courier/freight company. Logistics and cost thereof is

responsibility of the artist. A handling fee of \$50 will be charged to entrants who require the Federation Art Prize Committee to coordinate return postage / courier. We recommend sending prepaid return packaging with any entries to avoid the handling fee.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

13. The organisers will exercise all reasonable care with the works submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any work whilst in their custody or for insurance on works, either during transport or exhibition. Please pack and/or box your work to avoid damage. We will re-use your packaging to re-pack/wrap/box but will not provide if not supplied initially. Insurance is highly recommended.
14. The organisers reserve the right not to display any work.
15. Judges' decisions are final.
16. Collection of artworks from Oddfellows Hall is strictly Sunday 11th June between 14:00 & 15:00. Any submitted work not collected by the nominated dates will be given 30 days notice by the organisers of their intention to sell or otherwise dispose of the work. Thereafter, the organisers shall be under no liability whatsoever to the artist in respect to its disposal.
17. Courier collection of works must occur Tuesday 13th June between 16:00 & 18:00 from Memorial Hall, 86-88 Sanger Street, Corowa NSW 2646. Contact: P. Nielsen 0437 690 127
18. The winner of the Federation Photo Prize 2023 will receive \$2,000. The winning work is automatically acquisitive (ie. the work will automatically enter the Federation Council art collection). The artist consents to the display of the work at the Federation Council Art Space Gallery.'
19. A commission of 25% will be retained by the organiser on all works sold.
20. The artist for a sold work, and/or a prize winner, will be required to complete a Federation Council New Creditor Form nominating a bank account. The form will be issued within 30 days of the close of the prize. Proof of ID and a copy of a bank statement with name and bank details is required to be submitted with the New Creditor Form. Payment via EFT will occur within 45 days from receipt of the form.
21. Non-receipt of the required New Creditor Form within 60 days of receiving the form will by default result in non-payment by the organiser. There will be no avenue of recourse to the organiser under such circumstances.
22. Works sold must remain on exhibition until the event closes, except in circumstances where the purchaser lives more than one hour from Corowa.
23. Courier or postal services for works purchased is by arrangement between the Artist and Purchaser. Fed Art Prize will facilitate contact between Artist and Purchaser.
24. The organiser reserves the right to reproduce (including photography) the work in material form, publish and communicate the work to the public for the purposes of marketing, publicity, educational, publication and archival uses of the organisers in relation to the prize and its exhibition in all media; digital and electronic, broadcasting and print. It is the Artist's responsibility, not the organisers, to advise any Purchaser of the work, of these rights granted to the organisers. The artist will be attributed when exhibiting, reproducing or publishing the work or communicating the work to the public, unless it is reasonable in all circumstances not to do so.
25. Artists are encouraged to provide a personal profile/CV to assist with sales.
26. All artists are encouraged to attend the Opening Night party and Awards Ceremony. Tickets will be released for purchase closer to the opening night. (18:00, Friday 2nd June 2023).
27. Force Majeure - Where, for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the organisers (eg. Pandemic; flood; fire; orders or regulations; government directions; emergency events), the exhibition is hindered or prevented from being held during the advertising dates, the organisers reserve the right to vary, postpone or cancel the competition by notification to entrants and by public notice on its official social media.
28. To ensure a fair and equal competitive environment, we require that all conditions and requirements of entry be met.
29. Failure to comply with any of the above Terms & Conditions may result in non-entry or disqualification.
